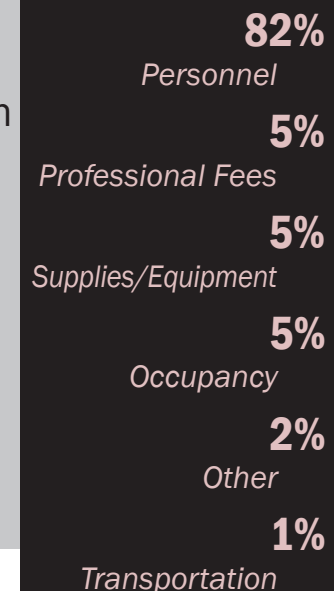

The Programs

Tanager Place serves more than 3,000 youth and their families each year.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS

The Expressive Arts Program is a key component of children's treatment, offering both music therapy and art therapy to youth on our inpatient campus and in the outpatient clinics.

CHILDREN OF PROMISE

A strong mentoring program for children who have a family member involved in the correctional or judicial systems. Bi-monthly educational and social experiences.

LGBTQ+ YOUTH CENTER

Safe and confidential space for LGBTQ+ youth, families and allies. Diverse programs provide skill building opportunities and combat social isolation.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH CLINICS

Clinics, located in Cedar Rapids and Coralville, offer diagnosis, assessment and treatment for a variety of mental health issues and specialize in child psychiatry, psychological testing, play therapy, music therapy and autism spectrum treatment.

BEHAVIORAL HEALTH INTERVENTION SERVICES

Skill building services offered to children and their families to increase the youth's functioning in all environments.

CAMP TANAGER

Camp offers a unique summer experience to children who are economically or medically disadvantaged, and is Iowa's only program, thanks to donors, to offer free summer camp to at-risk youth. Year-round programming offers special camps, rentals and day camp opportunities.

SCHOOL BASED PROGRAM

Tanager Place is contracted by area school districts to provide comprehensive holistic care to students. Innovative and evidence-based treatment is offered to children and families struggling with mental and behavioral health issues. Observation and training sessions are offered annually to districts.

PEDIATRIC INTEGRATED HEALTH

Offers a professional case management team for families with Medicaid-eligible children. Support provides advocacy for behavioral and physical health care needs.

INPATIENT PROGRAM

Our inpatient program houses 68 children who are dealing with severe psychiatric challenges and provides a health inpatient environment conducive to healing and restoration.

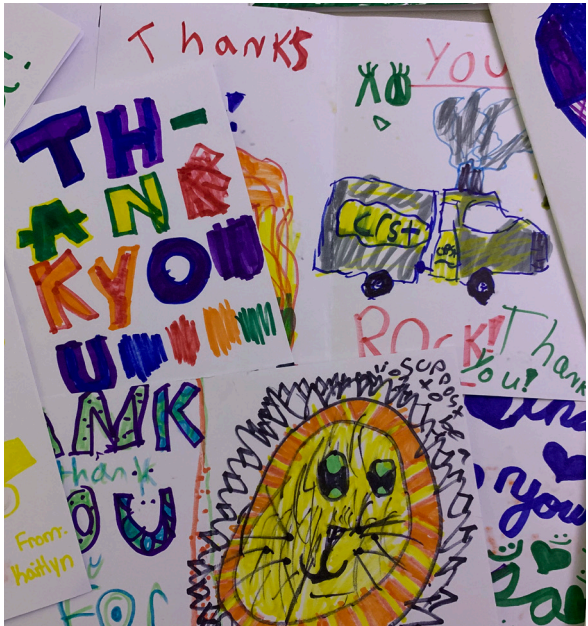
